All Quiet on the Western Front was not eligible for SAG awards.

This was the first time in its history that a SAG award went to an Asian actor with two from EEAAO winning an award. EEAAO has also won the Director's Guild and Producer's Guild awards.

The SAG Awards has one of the best track records with the academy: SAG has only missed five times in Best Actor, seven times in Best Actress, nine times in Best Supporting Actor and eight times in Best Supporting Actress. In its 25-year history, SAG has only had a direct match in all four Oscar acting races seven times. It usually goes 3/4. My prediction is that this year will be one of the few times it only goes 2/4.
